Irrigation water is OFF the Week of October 20th. Schedule the blow out of your system to avoid freeze damage.

Trash cans must be placed behind fence within 24 hours of trash/recycling pick up. Cans are to be placed in the gutter and 3ft apart as per Waste Management.





If your property borders 17 1/4 Rd (Mesa) or 17 1/2 Rd (Maple), you are responsible to keep weeds on the road side maintained and remove dead weeds from spraying. Thank you to those who stayed on top of it this summer!
